Tax Exemption: 501c4 organizations are not necessarily exempt from federal income tax. These organizations are Civic Leagues, Social Welfare Organizations and Local Associations of Employees.

501c6

Tax Exemption: 501c6 organizations are exempt from federal tax income. These organizations are Business Leagues, Chambers of Commerce, Real Estate Boards etc.
